

Midland Regional Director 1st Quarter Report (Jul-Sept 2011)

Overview

This quarter was busy with sector wide final consultation being undertaken for a number of key Midland strategic documents.

The Midland Clinical Governance project led by Deirdre Mulligan commenced in May 2011 was finalised with the project report being signed off by the HealthShare CE.

The Midland Co-existing Problems Levels of Competency Framework workshops were completed and the final draft was signed off by the Midland Region Addictions forum in May 2011 which was attended by the Ministry of Health and Matua Raki.

The Ministry of Health PRIMHD NGO Stage 3 - 5 project was completed on the 30th of June 2011. This was a significant piece of work for the Midland region who has the highest number of NGOs nationally and the highest number of Kaupapa NGOs.

The Midland Regional Forums strategic planning days were held over the months of August and September and were supported by the Midland Region MH&A Network team.
